IV. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA-

A Special TBC meeting is scheduled for 11/26/07 at 1 p.m. for continuation of FY08 Budget meeting. A Natural Resource Committee is scheduled at 10 a.m.

Councilman Benson moved to approve the agenda as presented, Councilwoman Brugh seconded the motion.

VOTE: 6 ayes – 0 nay; motion passed unanimously.

A. Louella Young Bear/Vernon Young Bear Discussion: Vernon Young Bear updates Council on his case. Councilman Packineau moved to authorize TAT Legal Department to research and review this case of Vernon Young Bear, Cops Fast Sergeant and present to Council on 11/26/07.

Discussion: Councilman Wolf commented on the lack of representation of the BIA on his behalf when this incident occurred because Vernon was in uniform and on duty.

B. Harriet Good Iron

Councilman Whitecalfe moved to approve of a memorial financial request in honor of Nathan J. Goodiron in the amount of \$43,325.00 to the Goodiron family for this weekend memorial powwow. The payment arrangements will be half of this amount will be a loan and the other half will be a grant on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes. Councilman Hale seconded the motion. Discussion: Councilman Hale noted that Harriet Goodiron is willing to take out a loan for this until the Life Insurance of Nathan J. Goodiron is received.

VOTE: 7 ayes - 0 nay; motion passed unanimously. (Councilman Whitecalfe via conference call)

Councilman Packineau moved to approve to transfer of \$30,000.00 to the Small Loans Program. Councilman Whitecalfe seconded the motion.

Discussion: Councilman Hale noted on the payments received from existing loans is not enough. Amendment of motion to include the maximum loan amount request is \$500.00 for the next six months. The treasurer will work with Connie Wilkinson at Tribal Housing Program in regards to Cammie Gosnell housing loan request. VOTE: 7 ayes – 0 nay; motion passed. Councilman Hale moved to approve the resolution of the Nu'eta Albet Trust Insurance Services, Inc., subject of review of TAT Legal Department for amendments. Councilman Packineau seconded the motion.
