

THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL HEALTH MEETING NO. 13-02-LKH FEBRUARY 04. 2013

CALL TO ORDER:

Committee Chairman Ken Hall called the meeting to order at 1:20 pm.

ROLL CALL: Present) Committee member Ken Hall, Committee Member V. Judy Brugh and Committee member, Randy Phelan. A quorum is established with three members present.

01. APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

Councilman Phelan moved to approve the agenda as amended. Councilwoman Brugh seconded the motion.

MOTION: Councilwoman Brugh moved for approval to send a recommendation to the Tribe to cover travel costs of the KDU patients who have to go out of town to dialyze because lack of chair space. Mileage and Per Diem will be taken out of the KDU Budget. When patients have to dialyze early, they will spend the night, with straight up mileage. \$250 overnight-- for the day its \$150. Councilman Phelan seconded the motion. "Standard of Care." sounds like they are not updating.


Councilman Phelan motioned to invite the City Council to the Health Committee on March 4, 2013. Councilwoman Brugh seconded the motion.
