CALL TO ORDER:

Councilman Fred Fox presided and called the meeting to order at 1:25 p.m. **ROLL CALL:**

Present: Councilwoman Judy Brugh, Councilman Fred Fox and Councilman Ken Hall. A quorum was established with three members present.
