

THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL NATURAL RESOURCE COMMITTEE MEETING NO. 14--FF MAY 15, 2014, 1:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Fred Fox called the meeting to order at 1:41 pm.

PRAYER:

Councilman Ken Hall gave the invocation.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Chairman Fred Fox, Councilman Ken Hall and Councilman Randy Phelan are present. A quorum is established.

1. RIGHT-OF-WAY & SET BACK: Carson Hood, Energy Department

Councilman Hall moved to forward to full TBC the Right-of-way application with the exemption of charge to be not higher than \$6000. Councilman Phelan seconded the motion.
