- 2) Arikara Wanbdi Waci & Dancing Eagle Perkins
 Wanbdi Waci provided a summary of activities; described a recent visit to the Salish tribe to gather ideas for teaching and comparing barriers. We are about 100 pages into a new text. Techniques utilizing Total Physical Response (TPR). Class starting this Monday for everyone. Just finished working on personal histories of elders in a collaborative effort with a doctoral student. Starting singing classes in the evening for the youth. Brad Kroupa has finished his dissertation and published two articles. He also substituted for the High School Arikara teacher for a week.

5) New Town - Marc Bluestone

Presented a written department report. We are 12 students down from last report. Mostly associated with the oil industry. Just hired two para educators last week. Professional day and teacher development completed. Attended the ND Native American Science Fair and placed 16 students. Spelling Bee last week with grade 1-5 and had 12 that are advancing to the County Bee. K-5 projects concerning Civil Rights completed with students completing biographies. Winterfest activities this and rivalry games against Parshall. Will be recognizing senior speech kids. Middle of the sports season. ICU implementation continues. Mentoring program is continuing. No school on the 15th and Parent/Teacher Conference coming up. Working on infrastructure project, Veteran's Wall completed in April. Hand Games night that brought in 42 kids. Fall Sports Awards on Feb. 8th. Possibly two new native teachers.

H. Education Trust Fund - Barb Miller

Presented an additional option for the trust fund to develop an endowment from a percentage of casino revenue.

Motion: Councilman Fred Fox moved to budget a million dollars to the trust fund. Councilman L. Kenneth Hall seconded the motion. Vote: 3-0-0. Motion carried.

I. Head Start Program - Kelly Bradfield

163 enrollment. 22 students on our waiting list. OHS petition to increase capacity or increase funding from the tribe. We are seeking to add another classroom in New Town 93 – additional staff) and Mandaree is looking at expanding. Parshall center is not maxed out. White Shield center count fluctuates. Twin Buttes could service 9 more children. Revamping Policies & Procedures to increase attendance statistics. Councilman L. Kenneth Hall asked Kelly Bradfield to put a budget together for the additional class room in New Town. Discussed teacher assessment activities and techniques. Brought in an Education Phycologist to work with parents of children exhibiting troubling behavior.
