Councilman Randy Phelan discussed moving Industry to the top of the Tribal Business Council agenda or as Councilman L. Kenneth Hall suggested having a Special Tribal Business Council for Industry by Resolution. Tom Wells & Liz Burnt discussed additional wells added need clearance and it creates a slowdown of BIA approval. No longer granting temporary water lines within BIA approval and the new regulations. The allottee can sign interest of ROW. Developing the proper language for grant temporary water lines at this time at the BIA. BIA is hoping to have the Temporary above ground water line ROW language developed by September 15th. Wilber Wilkinson, Spotted Tail Associates discussed contracting BIA Energy responsibilities by the tribe. Carson Hood Jr. stated that he is on the verge of losing his Federal grant and the staff that it funds. Also discussion of industry helping fund the Energy Department.
