B. Federal Representatives & Land Transfer 01-11-2017

Discussion of historical treaty lands taken by the U.S. government through treaty & executive order, and the Pick-Sloan Project for a total of 13.2 million acres. The Tribal Business Council through the Fort Berthold Minerals Restoration Act (1984) has sought the return of reservation lands condemned by the creation of the Garrison Dam. Tim LaPointe (Regional Director - Dept. Of Interior) & Chip Smith (Assistant for Environment, Tribal and Regulatory Affairs with the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works) were given thanks & praise for their work to return lands (25,000 acres) to the Three Affiliated Tribes. Each Council person provided a statement of thanks for their efforts. Chairman Mark N. Fox praised the Obama Administration for keeping to their word to return 500,000 acres to tribal nations.

C. Enrollment Request for Bear Sky Johnlee Gonzales 01-11-2017

The grandmothers of Bear Sky Johnlee Gonzales, born on January 5, 2017 at the Sanford Hospital in Bismarck, ND presented an enrollment issue. His parents are Standing Soldier Gonzales (Joy's son) 18 years old and Sean Deja Walking Eagle who is 17 years old. Standing Soldier is enrolled with the Yankton Sioux Tribe in SD and Sean Deja is from Spirit Lake. Requesting that the Tribal Business Council consider allowing enrollment of the child with inclusion of grandfather's lineage as a TAT member. Sevant Taft stated that the child falls below the 1/8 requirement.


