IV. TEXX LONE BEAR

A. Maxine Buffalo Land Exchange

Seeking a land exchange for allotment 2101-B. Appraisals have returned and the land is appraised at \$680/acre for \$67,150 for 40 acres of property near the Mandaree Pow-wow grounds. She has been waiting 32 years for the land exchange. Keith White Owl home site was approved in a section of the land she is requesting so Texx Lone Bear found another 2.5 acres adjoining her home site to the north to bring it up to 40 acres. Rural water line runs through the property and she is willing to sign an easement to allow access for maintenance.

B. Veronica Serdahl Land Exchange

Has 40 acres (3 tracks) worth \$32,400 at \$810/acre for exchange. Would like to trade for land closer to the road, on top, and to the west near her son's land.

Discussion: The \$25 difference to be paid to Maxine Bolman and automatically give elders the difference in cash for the future.

C. Nancy Fox Land Exchange.

Property appraised and Nancy Fox has yet to decide on what property she would want. Discussion of value differences between White Shield and Mandaree.

D. Donavon Dixon

Donovan Dixon joined the meeting via phone to discuss his concern that he has been overlooked for a grazing lease. He found out that Tom Bruer had the lease on the land that he hand submitted his application for. Councilman Randy Phelan asked Ardel Jean Baker to look it up in the minutes from a prior NRC. Councilman Fred Fox recommended acquiring Howard Wilkinson's old leases. Texx Lone Bear will get the leases done by April 19th council meeting. Almit Bruer is exchanging farm land that Donovan Dixon may be interested when it comes available.

F. BIA/Tribal Capital Building – Al Nygard, CEO

A&E completed with an access road near the existing building near the roping area. RFP going out in 10 days. Seeking assistance from USDA. Two designs with the first being with the B.I.A. having an entire floor and the second being with separate building but connected. Basement area would be utilized for records archives that are now sitting in the pods. Also to digitally

archive these records. The purpose of the building on the tribal side would be for all the Administrative and Executive offices. Councilman Randy Phelan recommended a helicopter landing pad that could be put on the roof or next to the building. Al Nygard informed the Committee that once the bids come back we will have the Council decide how they want it. Additionally, we would like to add another office building just to the west that should be completed y the end of the fiscal year in September that would have space for 20 offices. It would cost the Tribe about a million and a half dollars to upgrade this current tribal building and it is not feasible.

G. Myron Good Bird (Ruff) Home Site – Valerie Hosie

Awarded a home site on T897-A. Was told he was in trespass and moved his trailer. No lease document has been found and he is trying to get a home site and is seeking to return to the site. Valorie Hosie will research the land to insure the property is not leased already and verify it is available.

H. Cynthia Good Bird Home Site – Valerie Mayer

Seeking a home site in Mandaree. Councilman Randy Phelan informed that committee that the area around the pow-wow grounds needs to be zone out development and he won't be approving any home site in the area.

I. Land Buy Back – Caleb Dogeagle

Caleb Dogeagle provided a summary of the Land Buy-Back training/meetings. The program is set to start next spring of 2018. Informational meetings and other events will take place to publicize the program. In prior meetings the most common questions were; "How do we do the buyback program?" and "Do we have to sell our own lands?" The answer of course is No. Councilman Randy Phelan would like to see the program expedited so the tribe does not miss out on the amount allocated. Councilman Randy Phelan believes the \$56 million allocation is way too low for Fort Berthold lands due to the oil boom. The program has assured the Tribe that the appraisals will be above fair market value.
