



**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION**

***A Resolution Entitled: "Land Purchase – Juan Carlos Peinado - West Segment."***

**WHEREAS,** The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation, also known as the Three Affiliated Tribes ("MHA Nation" or "Tribes"), having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, the authority under said Act, and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws (the Constitution) under said Act, and

**WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the MHA Nation; and

**WHEREAS,** The Constitution authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the MHA Nation and of the enrolled members thereof; and

**WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt Resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Business Council, its agencies, and officials; and

**WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes has determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to acquire land; and

**WHEREAS,** The Tribal Business Council has considered the location of the below-described land, the potential public and economically beneficial use of the land, and Tribal Self-determination; and

**WHEREAS,** After such consideration the Tribal Business Council approves the purchase of said land pending legal review and the drafting of appurtenant documentation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby approves the purchase of the surface described below from:

**Juan Carlos Peinado, Tribal Member**

For cash consideration of \$24,000.00, which is the appraised value, utilizing funds from FY2023 560 Land Purchase Account, and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Business Council, its Secretary, the Superintendent of the Fort Berthold Agency, the Area Director, and Commissioner of the Indian Affairs to prepare all documents and do all things necessary to transfer title of the land to the United States of America, in trust for the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation, to wit:

**Allotment 301-1948-A, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, Township 148 North, Range 92 West, Dunn County, 5<sup>th</sup> PM of North Dakota, containing a 100% interest, containing 25 acres, more or less, appraised at a value of \$24,000.00.**




**CERTIFICATION**
