- NOW THE MOVE NO. IT MANAGED, By the Tribal Business Council of the Three affiliated Tribes that J. L. Lord accompany the Tribel Business Council on to forthcoming trips to Washington, D. G. and that sufficient funds for the purpose of paying his expenses to and from Washington, D. C. be withdrawn and also to cover the period of time he is to remain there.
