WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has found it necessary to remain in Washington, D. C. for several days to properly and effectively accomplish tribal business, and

WHEREAS, business matters must be taken care of and a secretary is required to keep minutes of various meetings held in conjunction with tribal affairs, and

WHEREAS, Rose Marie Mandan, is discerned a proper and qualified person to do certain clerical work for the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Rose Marie Mandan be employed to perform certain clerical duties for the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes during their stay in Washington, D. C. and that she be paid the sum of \$75.00 to perform these duties and that a check for this sum be issued to her forthwith.
