## HESOLUTION OF THE SOUTENING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BEETHOLD RESERVATION

MHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under this Act, and

MEREAS, Mervel Hall, an enrolled member of the Tribe, come unrestricted land adjoining Tribal comed land on Sear Len Creek in the Mostern Segment of the Reservation described as former Allotment No. 601-A, Sinkt Section 16, T. 150 N., R. 94 N., of the Fifth Frincipal Meridian, Ackensis County, North Dakota, containing SO acres, and

MMERRES, Marvel Hall desires to sell the land and has had offers to purchase from non-Indian stockmen for assumts up to \$18,000.00, and

deminately livestock production area and is considered of importance for Indian use because of its location on Bear Den Creek which furnishes stock water all year around and is ideally located as a site for a winter feed area for livestock and is also a possible recreational site in connection with the Garrison Reservoir, and

WHEREAS, Hervel Fall is indebted to the Three Affiliated Tribes in the amount of \$5,186.22 which is practically uncollectable at the present time, and

THERENS, Hervel Hall has offered to sell the lend and improvements located thereon to the Tribe for \$15,000.00 and pay the indebtedness from the proceeds of the sale, and

WHEREAS, after acquisition by the Three Affiliated Tribes, the tract, along with the adjoining 240 acres of Tribal owned land, could be leased out as a ranch headquarters site and winter feed camp, the fair annual rental to be determined by an appraiser of the Eureau of Indian Affairs, thereby giving the Three Affiliated Tribes a good annual return for its investment, and

PHEREAS, it is for the best interest of the Tribe to purchase the key tract and the improvements located therein for Indian use and to collect a delinquent Tribal debt,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESCRIED, that the land described above be acquired by the United States of America in trust for The Three Affiliated Tribes for the sum of \$15,000.00 to be paid from Tribal funds, excepting and reserving from the conveyance all oil, gas and other minerals, it being understood and agreed that the sum of \$15,000.00 is to be paid for the surface of the land and the improvements located thereon, exclusive of mineral rights.

HE IT FURTHER RESCLVED, that the total indebtedness of Hervel Hall to the Three Affiliated Tribes be withhold from the purchase price and applied on his Tribal indebtedness in accordance with his offer.

BE IT FURTHER RESCLVED, that the governing body of the Three Affiliated Tribes to familiar with the characteristics of the land and the improvements located thereon and specifically requests that the purchase be unde without the formality of the current appraisal of the property because of the fact the owner was offered as much as \$18,000.00 for the property by a non-Indian stockmen, which is in excess of the sale price of \$15,000.00 offered to the Tribe; that the governing body of The Three Affiliated Tribes considered this tract a key tract and that its acquisition in accordance with the foregoing is highly important to the welfare of the numbers of the Tribe residing in the Mestern Segment of the Fort Fortheld Reservation.

## CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Pusiness Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 10 members of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a Special meeting, thereof duly called, noticed, convened, and held on the 23rd day of August, 1960; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 7 members, 9 members opposed, 9 passed, 9 abstentions, and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way. Chairman voting.
