## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

MHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under this Act, and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes reaffirm resolution 60-h5 stating, Mervel Hall, an enrolled member of the Tribe, owns unrestricted land adjoining Tribal owned land on Bear Den Creek in the Nestern Segment of the Reservation described as former Allotment No. 601-A, 52NW4 Section 16, T. 150 N., R. 9h W., of the Fifth Principal Meridian, McNenzie County, North Dakota, containing 80 acres, and

WHEREAS, Mervel Hall desires to sell the land and has had offers to purchase from non-Indian stockmen for amounts up to \$18,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the land is located in the Western Segment of the Reservation in a predominately livestock production area and is considered of importance for Indian use because of its location on Bear Den Creek which furnishes stock water all year around and is ideally located as a site for winter feed area for livestock and is also a possible recreational site in connection with the Garrison Reservoir, and

WHEREAS, Mervel Hall is indebted to the Three Affiliated Tribes in the amount of \$5,186.22 which is practically uncollectable at the present time, and

WHEREAS, Mervel Hall has offered to sell the land and improvements located thereon to the Tribe for \$15,000.00 and pay the indebtedness from the proceeds of the sale, and

whereas, after acquisition by the Three Affiliated Tribes, the tract, along with the adjoining 240 acres of Tribel owned land, could be leased out as a ranch head-quarters site and winter feed camp, the fair annual rental to be determined by an appraiser of the Breau of Indian Affairs, thereby giving the Three Affiliated Tribes a good annual return for its investment, and

MHEREAS, it is for the best interest of the Tribe to purchase the key tract and the improvements located thereon for Indian use and to collect a delinquent Tribal debt,

NOW, THEREFORE HE IT RESCLVED, that the land described above be acquired by the United States of America in trust for the Three Affiliated Tribes for the sum of \$15,000.00 to be paid from Tribal funds, excepting and reserving from the conveyance all oil, gas and other minerals, it being understood and agreed that the sum of \$15,000.00 is to be paid for the surface of the land and the improvements located thereon, exclusive of mineral rights.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVER, that the total indebtedness of Mervel Hall to the Three Affiliated Tribes be withheld from the purchase price and applied on his Tribal indebtedness in accordance with his offer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Three Affiliated Tribes is familiar with the characteristics of the land and the improvements located thereon and specifically requests that the purchase be made without the formality of the current appraisal of the property because of the fact the owner was offered as much as \$18,000.00 for the property by a non-Indian stockman, which is in excess of the sale price of \$15,000.00 offered to the Tribe; that the governing body of The Three Affiliated Tribes considered this tract a key tract and that its acquisition in accordance with the foregoing is highly important to the welfare of the members of the Tribe residing in the western comment of the Fort Berthold Reservation.
