- WHEREAS, the contract of employment between the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation and Jonathan C. Eaton, Jr., relative to the prosecution of claims known as Docket Nos. 350-B and 350-C, against the United States, pending before the Indian Claims Commission, namely; Contract No. 14-20-0100-5883 has provided the Tribe with budget estimates of travel expenses, and
- WHEREAS, Jonathan C. Eaton, Jr., estimates two trips to Washington, D. C., at approximately \$350.00 per trip within the next twelve months and said amount to be included in the Tribal budget.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation that Jonathan C. Eaton, Jr., is hereby authorized to incur necessary and proper expenses under said Contract for two trips to Washington, D. C., at approximately \$350.00 per trip within the next twelve months and to be paid from the Tribal funds.
