- WHEREAS, consideration has been given to the construction of a bridge in the Charging Eagle Bay Area which would provide accessibility to many areas of Lake Sakakawea not presently accessible, and
- WHEREAS, construction of said bridge in the Charging Eagle Bay Area would prove that such additional development will be of great benefit to the people of the State of North Dakota as a whole in attracting tourism and travel development.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation whole-heartedly support construction of said bridge.
