RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribal Corporation charge the Tribal Business Council with the responsibility of performing all legal acts for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, At present there is no provision for Industrial Arts at Mandaree School; and

WHEREAS, There is need for some type of practical or industrial arts as a background for vocational skills; and

WHEREAS, Some students are not college bound among the Mandaree students;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes request that a vocational training program related to Industrial Arts (woodworking, welding, metal work, etc.) be established.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a qualified instructor be hired and adequate space and equipment for this program be provided.
