THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
AND ASSOCIATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Three affiliated Tribes of the Fort Sisseton Indian Reservation in the State of North Dakota were organized and declared by the Federal Government on June 13, 1888, and authority is granted in the Constitution and by laws, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Indian Affairs has advised a willingness to listen to the Indian tribes throughout the nation relative to the filling of vacant positions in the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

WHEREAS, The Three affiliated Tribes of the Fort Sisseton Indian Reservation, North Dakota, appreciate this opportunity of making their Indian women in regard to the filling of these positions and wish this opportunity be presented to an individual to fill the vacancy as chief of the law and order branch, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Washington, D. C.,

AND WHEREAS it is shown, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three affiliated Tribes of the Fort Sisseton Indian Reservation, North Dakota, do request that Mr. William F. Walker, who is presently acting Special Officer for the Abandonment Act, be appointed to fill this vacancy. Mr. Walker has spent 17 years as a law enforcement officer, has a degree in education, and is a member of the Grand Jurors. In 1931, as an example of his loyalty and cooperation with the Indian people with whom he has worked, he received a letter of appreciation from the Tribal Business Council of the Pine Ridge Reservation, Pine Ridge, South Dakota, for his years of service as agency Special Officer of the Pine Ridge Reservation. A certificate such as that he rarely gives and he greatly respects every consideration he gives to Mr. William F. Walker in the filling of this vacancy as chief of the law and order branch, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Washington, D. C.,
