RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and authority is granted under this Act, and
- WHEREAS, The waters of Lake Sakakawea defintely divided the reservation into five segments making a large amount of travel to go from one segment to another, and
- WHEREAS, The majority of the residents operate small farms and ranches, and
- WHEREAS, The problems are greater and more complex requiring more personnel contact to resolve, and
- WHEREAS, The present State Extension staff does not have sufficient personnel to do all the field work, and
- WHEREAS, It is the stated policy of this Council to urge the hiring of qualified members of the Tribe first when openings are available.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation requests that the State Extension Service assign an Assistant Extension Agent and an Assistant Home Agent, both members of the Tribe, to the Fort Berthold Reservation to assist with the services provided by the State Extension Service.

CERTIFICATION

I, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of ten members of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a Special meeting, thereof duly called, noticed, convened and held on the 30th day of March 1970; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 6 members, 0 members opposed, 0 members passed, O members abstained, and that the said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
