

THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation to an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted in the Constitution and By-Laws, and

WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Indian Reservation boundary has been reaffirmed by an opinion of the Solicitor of the United States Department of Interior dated March 11, 1936.

WHEREAS, This reaffirmation places a burden and responsibility upon the Three Affiliated Tribes and the Federal Government to provide protection to the lives and property of the Indian residents of this area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs make available such means as may be needed for additional police officers, also requests funds for them to carry out their responsibilities in an efficient manner to fulfill this obligation.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 14 members of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a special meeting, thereof only called, noticed, convened, and held on the 30 day of March, 1936; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 6 members, 0 members opposed, 0 abstentions, 0 passed, and that the said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way. (Chairman not voting.)
