## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under this Act; and
- WHEREAS, the North Dakota Century Code contains a section relating to compulsory jurisdiction of Indian citizens in the state, and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 2349 provides for an amendment to the North Dakota Century Code to require acceptance of state jurisdiction by Indian citizens, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed legislation contains the provision that "upon acceptance by Indian citizens in a manner provided by this chapter", and
- WHEREAS, the manner of acceptance has been defined in Section 406 of Public Law 90-284,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Three Affiliated Tribes Business Council does not oppose the intent of Senate Bill 2349, but encourages the North Dakota Legislature to provide for concurrence by the Indian citizens in accordance with Section 406 of Public Law 90-284.
