RESOLUTION OF THE COVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BESTROLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 19, 1934, and authority is greated under said Act; and
- WEEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribal Corporation charge the Tribal Basiness Council with the responsibility of performing all legal acts for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members: and
- WHEREAS, It is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other inadequate housing, to prevent the apread of slame and blight, and to realize as soon as feesible the goal of a decent home in a suitable living environment for all of its citizens; and
- WHEREAS, Under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, the United States of American, seting through the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is authorized to provide financial assistance to local public bousing agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of low-rent housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and
- WHEREAS, The Act provides that there shall be local determination of need for low-rent housing to meet needs not being edequately met by private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a public housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning in respect to any low-rent housing projects unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution approved the application of the public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and
- WREREAS, The Fort Barthold Housing Authority (herein called the "Local Authority") is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a preliminary loss to cover the costs of surveys and planning in connection with the development of low-rest bousing;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribas of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation, North Dakots, as follows:
 - That there exists in the Fort Berthold Indias Reservation in North Dakota a need for such low-rest housing which is not being met by private enterprise;

2. That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for a preliminary loss in an assumt not to exceed Ten Thomsend Dollers (\$10,000) for surveys and planning in connection with low-rest bousing projects of not to exceed approximately One Hundred Twenty-five (125) dwelling units is hereby approved.
