RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribal Corporation charge the Tribal Business Council with the responsibility of performing all legal acts for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Conditions exist on the Fort Berthold Reservation warranting assistance in supplying food; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribe is without cash resources to provide a food commodity program; and
- WHEREAS, The Department of Agriculture sponsors a program to provide surplus commodities to needy families; and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has the capability to enter into a contract with the Three Affiliated Tribes to provide funds for the operation of such a program;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes requests that said program of the Department of Agriculture to provide surplus commodities be continued on the Fort Berthold Reservation, and that the Bureau of Indian Affairs contract with the Three Affiliated Tribes Business Council for the operation of said program.
