Resolution No. 71-111 RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under said Act; and

- WHEREAS, There exists a need for a special Teacher Aide Education Program to meet the needs of the East Segment students attending the White Shield School; and
- WHEREAS, Such a special Program can be funded under Title I authority; and

WHEREAS, Such Program can best be administered by the Tribal Business Council and/or Parent Council at White Shield; and

WHEREAS, The professional resources for supervision of a Title I Program is available within the community of White Shield.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby requests and accepts the responsibility of administering a Title I contract for the White Shield School to provide five teacher aides plus one professional teacher during Fiscal Year 1972;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Parent Council organization of the White Shield community is redelegated the Program execution.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 10 members of whom $\frac{77}{2}$ constituting a quorum were present at a Regular meeting, thereof duly called, noticed, convened and held on the $\frac{772}{2}$ day of September, 1971; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of $\frac{12}{2}$ members, $\frac{12}{2}$ members opposed, $\frac{12}{2}$ abstentions, $\frac{12}{2}$ passed, and that the said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way. Chairman not voting.
