

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Corporation is in an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and authority is granted under said Act, and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribal Corporation charge the Tribal Business Council with the responsibility of performing all legal acts for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, Applications for Grant Aid must be initiated at the Agency level to determine tribal enrollment and blood quantum, and
- WHEREAS, When an application is not complete, the Agency has closer contact with the applicant and can urge students to complete necessary materials at an early date, and
- WHEREAS, The Agency now has approximately 200 applications, the Area now has 2,000 applications. The agency is in a better position to give more individual assistance to each applicant and faster service for approval than the Area, and
- WHEREAS, With less contacts to be made the Local Agency could give faster and more efficient service to the students, and
- WHEREAS, With funds at Local control, when a student drops out of college or does not enroll in college, the local agency would have immediate contact with the local college and could re-allocate the funds to other students at an early date,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of The Three Affiliated Tribes strongly urge that funds for the college grant program be allocated to the local Agency in the regular Education budget. To be administered by the local Agency.

Funds should be provided on the basis of the per cent of students attending college from that Agency, using past college figures for determining funds to be allocated to each agency.

Employment Assistance has local control of their funds for their training applicants. The same should be done with the Grant Aid Program.
