## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under said Act, and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Corporate Charter of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to engage in business enterprises, and

- WHEREAS, To assist with the bi-annual Tribal Council Election a Tribal Election Board is appointed, and
- WHEREAS, Said Election Board was appointed for the September 5, 1972 election, and
- WHEREAS, The court ordered a re-election in the Western Segment and it was the Council's decision that they the Council would act as the Election Board for the re-election for the Western Segment and the previous Election Board be dissolved, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council, Three Affiliated Tribes hereby does dissolve the previously appointed Election Board retroactively as of November 30, 1972.
