NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes Museum "fully support the project as being a priority", for receipt of a \$4,000 grant from the Indian Development Fund of the Indian Affairs Commission.
