

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

Resolution No. 76-92

WHEREAS, this Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under this Act, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Land Committee of the Tribal Business Council approved of the purchase by the Tribe of the land described below, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to acquire the land, and, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby approves the purchase of the land described below, exclusive of minerals, including oil and gas, from

Henry Young Bird

for a cash consideration of \$ 3,900.00, which is the present fair market value, and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Business Council, its Secretary, the Superintendent of the Fort Berthold Agency, the Area Director, and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to prepare all documents and do all things necessary to transfer title of the lands to the United States of America in trust for the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, to wit:

The land is west of the fifth principal meridian, N. Dak.
