- WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes has a contract with Berman, Goldman & Ribakow, CPA's under contract #K51C14200354, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes duly agrees to pay for expert witness costs for period covering 1/1/72 3/31/73 in amount of \$6,795; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby approves to make payment from the expert witness funds held in the local IIM account for the tribe in the amount of \$6,795.00 to Berman, Goldman & Ribakow, CPA's.
