- WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal membes, and
- WHEREAS, the Western Segment Community of Mandaree has been approved of federal financial assistence for a water-line from Lake Sakakawea, and
- WHEREAS, the approval of funding was on July 15, 1975 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and the Indian Health Service, and
- WHEREAS. funds may be withdrawn shortly because of the failure of local agencies involved from proceeding with the project, and
- WHEREAS, presently, Mandaree's water is unsafe for human consumption.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this newly elected Tribal Business

 Council place this project on the highest priority immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other local agencies involved in this project assist the Tribal Business Council immediately.
