WHEREAS, This nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Council has reviewed the status of the trust funds on deposit in the U.S. Treasury, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council formally approved the budgeting of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Council on this 17th day of January the regular January session, hereby approves the Fiscal Year 1979 Budget for the Three Affiliated Tribes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribal Council shall request programmed U.S. Treasury funds as the need occurs.

All of the activities are operated under the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes approved on June 29, 1937. Resolution No. 79-10 is for the fiscal year 1979.

Permanent Authorization (Estimated 1979 \$403,500) Indefinite Authorization (Estimated 1979 \$324,300)

The Three Affiliated Tribes is an organized tribe under the IRA Act and under their Constitution and Charter, le amount of \$50,000. Treasurer is authorized to accept and disburse funds belonging to the Tribe. This official is bonded in
