

RESOLUTION NO. 79-20

WHEREAS, the Community Health Representative Program has reached a significant magnitude, both in numbers of CHR's and budget, and

WHEREAS, Congress has continued to provide funds to amortize the existing program and expand it each year, and

WHEREAS, there is presently a thrust to reduce the national budget whenever possible and every program is being closely scrutinized, and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the CHR Program it is imperative that Congress be made aware of the impact upon direct services and patient care by the CHR Program,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Council of the Fort Berthold Reservation, is hereby submitting the attached report as an official testimony as to the services rendered by the CHR Program, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Council recognizes that the CHR Program has in fact been the catalyst for:

1. individuals to move into specialized health fields
2. more efficient utilization of existing services
3. extending health care to the community
4. developing other community programs where there was a need.
