

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and authority is granted under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes has an obligation and a duty to provide for the peace and protection of the Tribal membership; and

WHEREAS, there is an increased incidence of juvenile crime on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe presently has in its employment a Tribal juvenile officer and probation officer in the person of Adolph Bell, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, besides Mr. Bell, there is only one (1) other juvenile officer on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation, said officer being a Bureau of Indian Affairs employee; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 8, Section 3 (a) of the Tribal Code grants that a Tribal probation officer have all of the authority of Tribal or Bureau police officers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Tribe to provide the Tribal juvenile officer/probation officer, Adolph Bell, Jr., with the necessary protections and training required in the position; and

WHEREAS, all Tribal and Bureau of Indian Affairs police officers receive a Special Officer's Deputy Commission issued in accordance with regulations set forth in 63 BIAM, Supplement 1, Release 10.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Adolph Bell, Jr., is granted all of the authority and powers of a Tribal and Bureau police officer in accordance with CLTAF 8-3 (a); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Special Officer shall issue to Mr. Bell a Deputy's Commission and all the powers and privileges said Deputy's Commission carries with it; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the Special Officer provide Mr. Bell with whatever training he deems necessary to improve Mr. Bell's effectiveness as a juvenile and probation officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the position of Tribal Juvenile Officer, be established with salary paid from the Criminal Justice Program, Contract Number AOOCL4206507.

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 11 members of whom 7 constituting a quorum, 8 were present at a Special Meeting, thereof duly called, noticed, convened and held on the 19 day of January, 1979; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 8 members, 0 members opposed, 0 members abstained, and that the said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
