

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOYD OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June, 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee of the State Legislature recommends abolishing the Indian Affairs Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Affairs Commission represents the Fort Berthold Reservation providing an important link to the State of North Dakota; and
- WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota receives federal funds to serve the entire North Dakota population including Indian reservations and has had conflicting regulations on service to reservations; and
- WHEREAS, Indian tribes being represented through the Indian Affairs Commission is of great importance to the Three Affiliated Tribes.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes supports House Bill 10-13, which provides the 1979-81 bienium budget of \$223,000 for the Indian Affairs Commission.
