WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefits of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes, Tribal Business Council has established as it's number one health priority, the control and treatment of alcoholism among it's populace; and

WHEREAS, The tribal health priority is being addressed through the Tribal Alcoholism Program; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Alcoholism Program has trailers for an Alcoholism Treatment Center but lack the funds for staffing and basic operational costs; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council supports the Community Development proposal for the funding of basic operational costs and staffing of the Alcoholism Treatment Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council supports this proposal as their top priority for Community Development funding.
