

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- HEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and authority is under said Act; and
- HEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws and Corporate Charter of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and
- HEREAS, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes has the responsibility to provide for effective law enforcement on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- HEREAS, the present statutory scheme of liquor laws provides inadequate legal enforcement of the concept that minors should not use, possess or have available intoxicating liquors until they reach legal age,
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Chapter 4 of the Tribal Code of Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes be amended to include a Section 57 to read as follows:

Section 57. Minors prohibited from obtaining alcoholic beverages and entering liquor establishments within the boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation.

- a. Any person under 21 years of age purchasing, attempting to purchase, or being in possession of alcoholic beverages, or furnishing money to any person for such purchase, or entering any licensed premises where alcoholic beverages are being sold or displayed, except a restaurant when accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or in accordance with Section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, or if he is a law enforcement officer in performance of official duty, shall be guilty of an offense.
- b. Any person who shall intentionally interfere with a law enforcement officer who is attempting to enforce part "a" of this section shall be deemed guilty of an offense.
- c. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this section shall be subject to a fine not greater than \$150 and incarceration for a period not exceeding 10 days or both fine and incarceration.
