

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 4, Section 36 of the Tribal Code sets the mandatory school age at 16; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 13, Section 6 (c) of the Tribal Code states a child must attend school until attaining age 18; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council acknowledges the contradictory provisions in the Tribal Code regarding mandatory school attendance age; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the mandatory school attendance age be set at 16.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Code be amended to reflect this change.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
