RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has for several months been observing the conduct of the appointed Tribal Judge Thomas Ewing; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has observed that Judge Thomas Ewing's conduct has disregarded sound legal principles and the cultural and historical customs and traditions observed by our people today; and
- WHEREAS, Thomas Ewing has jeopardized the well-being of the tribal government and the people of the Three Affiliated Tribes,
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that to protect the cultural and historical customs and traditions of the tribal government and the people of the Three Affiliated Tribes, the Tribal Business Council hereby discharges from the service as Tribal Judge effective this day, Thomas Ewing, that he shall hear no further matters within the Tribal Court system effective this day.
