- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, our society has become increasingly dependent on household chemicals to perform labor-saving, time-saving miracles for us; and on dangerous drugs to provide health-giving, life sustaining benefits; and
- WHEREAS, these products, when not used as intended or directed, can be hazardous; and
- WHEREAS, innocent children too often gain access to them; and
- WHEREAS, accidental poisonings among children continue at the rate of more than 100,000 annually, despite new packaging techniques;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, AUSTIN A. Cillette , Chairman of the Three Affinated Trials Tribal Council do hereby proclaim March 18-24, 1979 as Poison Prevention Week on the Fort Reservation. Further I direct the appropriate agencies of the Three Affinited Tribes Tribal Government and invite local organizations and individuals to participate in programs which will alert our citizens to the potential dangers in misusing medicines and household substances and promote effective safeguards against accidental poisoning.
