

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefits of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, a HUD news was received in which HUD Secretary Patricia Roberts Harris presented a planned new initiative to test ways of improving the design, quality and production of housing for American Indians, and
- WHEREAS, Professional construction managers' efforts to improve the production time and the quality of Indian housing are impoverishing the Indians, and
- WHEREAS, The news release solicits Indian input to improve or to devise an alternative method for better production time and the quality of Indian housing at lower per units costs,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation in North Dakota, that we express our cooperation and initiative with a proposal for subterranean homes which are more economical and efficient.
