

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 19, 1934, and the authority is under said Act; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Community White Shield in the Eastern segment of the Fort Berthold Reservation have expressed the desire for a Post Office for their community; and

WHEREAS, the Community of White Shield is a separate and distinct community within the Fort Berthold Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Community of White Shield desires acquisition of a Post Office for their community for several reasons;

- 1) future local employment,
- 2) enhanced community identity
- 3) more efficient and available mail service

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Business Council that we go on official record the following,

- 1) Request that the Postmaster in Bismarck, Mr. Urban Hagen expediate the request on the White Shield Community.
- 2) Request congressional assistance in securing of this request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman and Community Chairman of White Shield be authorized to follow up on this request.
