

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, it has become impractical for the Chief Judge to be available each time a need arises in commital cases; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter I, Section 10 of the Tribal Code grants the Tribal Business Council the power to grant additional powers to Magistrates when necessity arises; and
- WHEREAS, to insure the safety and welfare of the members it is necessary to provide additional powers to Magistrates to assure orderly procedure in the absence of the Chief Judge;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Magistrates Cletus Medicine Crow and Clement Baker are herein granted the power and authority of the Chief Judge in commital matters in the case of emergency or unavailability of Chief Judge; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this power shall extend for one (1) year.
