WHEREAS, This Corporation is an Indian Chartered Corporation as defined by the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is granted under this act, and

WHEREAS, Peter Fredericks, an enrolled member of the Three Affiliated Tribes, has blocked access to the homesite of Celina Young Bear Mossett, and

WHEREAS, there is no other route available to Celina Young Bear Mossett to gain access to her home, and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the United States Government to insure accessibility for all Indians to their homes on the Fort Berthold Reservation, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby request the Superintendent, Fort Berthold Agency, to initiate condemnation action against lands owned by Peter Fredericks to insure that Celina Young Bear Mossett, an enrolled member of the Three Affiliated Tribes, have access to her home.
