RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Article V Vacancies and Removal From Office, Section 1. If a council member or officer shall die, resign, or be permanently removed from the reservation, or be removed from office for cause, the council shall have full authority to appoint a qualified tribal member from the segment where the vacancy occurs to serve the unexpired term of said member or officer. However, in case the chairman's position becomes vacant due to the chairman's death, resignation, permanent removal from the reservation or removal from office for cause, the unexpired term of the chairman shall be filled by a member of the council, selected by a majority vote of the council. In that instance, the council shall promptly appoint, as herein provided, to fill the vacancy created by a council member assuming the chairman's position; and
- WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the East Segment due to the death of Council member, Larry M. Rush; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V, Section 1, the Tribal Business Council has deliberated at their Regular Council Meeting held June 14, 1979; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Louis Felix, Sr. is hereby appointed by the Tribal Business Council to serve the unexpired term of Larry M. Rush which expires September 1980.
