

RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL
OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Tribal Business Council to protect and preserve the health and welfare of the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes and Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 3 (D) of the Tribal Constitution grants the power to the Tribal Business Council "to remove or exclude from the limits of the Reservation, non-members of the Tribe"; and

WHEREAS, there has been shown that Doctor Kosa of the Public Health Clinic has shown:

- (a) to be a disruptive influence within the clinic,
- (b) unexceptable patient/physician relationships, and
- (c) to be unable to handle and withstand the pressures and duties of the physician position; to the point that the health care of the people of the Fort Berthold Reservation is in serious jeopardy; and

WHEREAS, there was due notice of a hearing scheduled this 21st day of August 1979 and said hearing was held to give Doctor Kosa her opportunity to clear herself of said charges against her; and

WHEREAS, Doctor Kosa was unable to show that said claims were not substantial and of a truthful nature;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Doctor Kosa be removed and excluded from within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation, and that she remove herself from within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation within three (3) hours.
