WHEREAS; The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and tenefit of the Tribe and Tribal members; and

WHEREAS; The Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Council has reviewed the status of the trust funds on deposit in the U.S. Treasury; and

WHEREAS; The Thibal Council formally approved the budgeting of their funds; and

WHEREAS; The Three Affiliated Tribes has gone on record by Resolution No. 79-226 to utilize \$64,142.00 of the Docket 350F trust funds programmed for "Parks & Recreation" to renovate & repair their laundromat that is situated in the Four Bears Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council hereby requests that the subject U.S. Treasury funds be withdrawn and placed in the Agency Depository upon approval of this Resolution.
