

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Community College was established to meet the academic and vocational needs of the Three Affiliated Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Community College does provide a comprehensive curriculum for light construction and secretarial science students; and
- WHEREAS, The students completing their training at the Fort Berthold Community College will enhance the quality and quantity of the local labor force; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council does support locally based Indian community colleges; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council grant employment preference to Fort Berthold Community College graduates; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that employment preference be based on locally trained applicants where applicable.
