## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes charge the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to protect and preserve the property, wildlife and natural resources of the Tribes, and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Office of Natural Resources and Energy Development Field Inspectors Office is currently seeking funding to allow continuance and expansion of it's oil and gas exploration monitoring services to the Tribes, and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes recognizes the need for these continued services to insure Fort Berthold natural resources protection in the area of oil and gas exploration and development, and also to insure the exercise of Indian Preference in employment on Fort Berthold, and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs Fort Berthold Agency has indicated that monies may be made available for the funding of this office by P.L. 93-638 Contract upon application by the Three Affiliated Tribes, and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes desires to make application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for these monies,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the attached Three Affiliated Tribes Office of Natural Resources and Energy Development Field Inspectors Office Proposal and Budget is hereby approved, and that this proposal be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for consideration.
