RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, WHEREAS. 1934, and authority under said Act; and

The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes WHEREAS. and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, In order to assure a constant, safe and sanitary water supply each entity using water from the Mandaree Water System will have to contribute towards the operation and maintenance costs, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that on July 1, 1980 the Three Affiliated Tribes Utilities Program shall assume the following responsibilities:

(1) Water fee collection.

(2) Operation and maintenance of Mandaree Water System.

(3) Provide the Mandaree Community a constant, safe and sanitary water supply from Lake Sakakawea.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by September 30, 1980 all housing units and other facilities utilizing water from the Mandaree Water System shall have water meters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that beginning July 1, 1980 the following water rate system shall apply to all housing units and other facilities utilizing water from the Mandaree Water System.
