## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, there exists a need for quality health care providers to be available to the Indian communities of Mandaree and White Shield and that this need also includes a corresponding medical records clerk to aid each provider; and
- WHEREAS, the quality health care providers were determined to be family nurse practioners, one for each of the communities mentioned above.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Three Affiliated Tribes will accept P. L. 93-638 authority to administer the services of two family nurse practioners and their associated medical records clerks whose authorized duties and services will be coordinated with the Minni-Tohe Indian Health Service Director and Medical Officer.
