

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes recognizes the need for the Community Health Representatives Program as an integral part of the Health Care Delivery System, by seeking renewal of the contract for FY 1981; and
- WHEREAS, the Community Health Representatives Program will place emphasis on accident prevention, diabetes, heart disease, and other major health problems of the Fort Berthold Reservation, the elderly as a priority group, with improve communication between Indian Health Services, the community and Tribal Programs; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes wishes to renew their contract with the Indian Health Services to continue the Community Health Representatives Program.
